A faculty position in
Veterinary Virology (open rank)
is available at the Institute of Veterinary Virology and Immunology (IVI).

The professor will be head of the Division of Virology and member of the Board of the IVI.

The IVI is a Swiss Federal Research Institute. Operation of the Divisions of Veterinary Virology and Veterinary Immunology is based on a performance contract between IVI and the Vetsuisse-Faculty, University of Bern. The IVI is located at two sites, i.e. Bern (campus of the Vetsuisse-Faculty) and Mithelhäusern. In Mithelhäusern, animal facilities operating under BSL-3Ag high containment conditions are available, allowing in vivo experiments with highly contagious animal diseases.

Apart from research, postgraduate training of doctoral/PhD students, the acquisition of extramural funding and diagnostic services, the professor's duties include the responsibility for teaching Virology to undergraduate students.

Requirements: Habilitation or equivalent scientific qualification; internationally recognized outstanding research in the field of virology with focus on farm animals; acquisition of highly competitive extramural funding and experience in undergraduate and postgraduate teaching. Dedication to continuous support of young researchers during their academic career has to be documented.

Fluency in German and French is desired.

Employment conditions follow the rules and legal framework of the University of Bern.
