Personal description by the Candidate for 2019-2022 Council:

I am MD. PhD (Federal University of Bahia - UFBA) with post-doctoral periods at the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (part of NIH -USA) and currently an investigator at Fundação Oswaldo Cruz (Fiocruz) working in immunoregulation of parasitic diseases, with emphasis on leishmaniasis and malaria. My 215 publications received 6,131 citations (5,657 without self citations) with an h-index of 44 (Web of Science at March 11,2019).

My scientific work was awarded in 2002 with “Premio OPAS-ALAI en Inmunologia Experimental” by the PanAmerican Health Organization and Associação Latinoamericana de Inmunologia; and the "UNESCO-Equatorial Guinea International Prize for Research in the Life Sciences” in 2015.

I have been President of the Brazilian Society for Immunology and a member of ALAI council. I served the Scientific Committee for the IUIS Congress held in Rio de Janeiro. At the Federal University of Bahia (UFBA) he was Director of the School of Medicine and Vice-Chancellor for Research and Graduate Studies. I have also served at the Brazilian National Research Council (CNPq) both as Director of Life Sciences and as Vice-President. I am currently a member of the Presidential National Council of Science and Technology.

I am a member of the Brazilian National Academy of Sciences, a Knight Grand Cross of the Brazilian National Order of Scientific Merit.
