

EDU Opportunities and Challenges



Opportunities:

- On-line format has been established (Zoom), will be adapted to future courses
- On-site courses planned for 2021: Argentina (May), Malawi (July), Tunisia (October),
 Chile (November): depends on further development of Corona pandemic
- On-line courses planned for 2021: Colombia (April)
- Additionally: Establish new format: 1-2 days practical (or virtual) workshops on specific topics (e.g. molecular diagnostic of allergy; FACS) for small groups of \approx 10 students

Challenges:

- Use Corona pandemic situation to establish flexible format for future courses: mixture of on-site and remote courses
- Develop modules which can be implemented in University courses
- Revamp Immunopaedia to be able to support more online courses, Webinars, improve registration process, etc.
- Establish an efficient mentoring program
