





Immunopaedia is a non-profit educational website which aims to promote cutting edge knowledge and research in basic and clinical immunology worldwide.

It provides a broad resource of immunological knowledge and clinical studies, covering the entire immune system, its function and how it is interrupted during disease.

Immunopaedia was awarded the Science Prize for Online Resources in Education (SPORE) in 2010. This was a first for a South African online initiative.
